Demonstration event in Rotterdam

Right after that, the participants attended the Tell me a Story presentation in the city library of Rotterdam. The event also raised interest among local tour guides and policy makers, which took part in it. Our first prize winner in the first round of the Tell me a Story contest told one of her stories about the region of Bodensee, Germany.

At the end we all enjoyed a very entertaining performance by Herco Kruik - a freelance writer, publisher and city guide in Rotterdam. He introduced his own Rotterdam city tour about the many nicknames the people from Rotterdam make up for their streets, buildings, bridges, art objects.

Demonstration event in Toro, Spain

Our second demonstration event was held in Toro, Spain. The participants from more than 10 European countries attended a guided tour through the TMAS stories locations with a local tour guide. It was very interesting to get in touch with the local culture and atmosphere.

Later on, our Spanish partners ToLingua presented the project to the locals which found it very interesting. The participants received the Tell me a Story book and were very excited about the idea of the project. Our second stage winner in the TMAS story contest Herco Kruik, told a story about its own city of Rotterdam. We all enjoyed our stay in Toro and we're looking forward to the next Tell me a Story event!
